A CIB is a document from the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) verifying the degree of Native blood of an Alaskan Native and can be obtained by submitting an application at the BIA office in Anchorage at 3601 C St., Suite 1100, Anchorage, Alaska 99503, by phone at: (800) 645-8465. All Alaskan Natives are encouraged to apply. The application must be accompanied by a state-certified copy of a birth certificate. Photocopies are not accepted. Once approved, the BIA office will mail your CIB to you. You may also want to visit the BIA office in Anchorage to obtain a credit card-sized CIB that includes your photo. Complete and mail the Birth Certificate Application Form to the address instructed on the form.
